
## **HYPERFOCAL DISTANCE**

for landscape photographers



Hyperfocal distance refers to the point at which you focus a lens to maximize depth of field. If you focus at the hyperfocal distance, you get the largest possible part of the scene sharp (in focus). When using the hyperfocal distance, you'll render everything from half of the hyperfocal distance to infinity acceptably sharp.
